Holt Hall Residential Visit

12th – 14th October 2020: Doves and Canaries

14th – 16th October 2020: Robins and Eagles

In the Autumn Term, Year 6 children have the opportunity to experience a residential trip to Holt Hall. Due to the size of the year group, we will be taking 2 classes at a time for 3 days of activities and 2 nights of sleep - hopefully! As your child will then be a member of Year 6 they will have the opportunity to take part in this experience.

The activities provided will be linked to Geography, Science, Art and PSHE objectives as set out in the National Curriculum studied in Year 6. It will give children the chance to experience a fantastic range of opportunities as well as being away from home. This has proved to be a valuable experience for Year 6 pupils who have attended in the past.

There will be an opportunity for parents to find out more and ask questions about the residential at White House Farm Primary School hall at 3.30pm on Thursday 26th March 2020.

The dates of the two visits will be;

- Monday 12th October to Wednesday 14th October 2019
- Wednesday 14th October to Friday 16th October 2019

Both visits will return to school by 3pm.

The cost of the trip is £148.00, which covers transport, insurance, activities, board and lodgings (breakfast x 2, lunch x 3, dinner x 2). This year's cost is slightly more than last year's due to a price increase from Holt Hall.

This residential is an optional extra and therefore without payment in full, children will not be able to attend. If you would like your child to participate in this residential visit, please complete the slip and return it by Friday 24th April. A deposit of £30.00 will also be required by this date to secure your child's place.

The total cost of the trip is payable via Parent Pay, or in cash/cheque and can be paid in instalments to spread the cost across a longer period. Parents on low income may be eligible to claim a bursary from the Joanna Scott Foundation. The Friends of Holt Hall have also previously granted bursaries to families with twins/triplets and also families with exceptional circumstances. Please enquire at our office for more details.

If your household has a low income, (for example, you may be receiving benefits), you may be eligible for a grant which could cover most of the cost of the trip from Anguish's Educational Foundation.
